1. ANCKARSVÄRD'S WAREHOUSE. Information centre for the cultural heritage reserve. Permanent exhibit about Karlslund and Summer Exhibition. Operated by Örebro Municipality.

33. KARLSLUND POWER STATION. From 1897, one of the oldest power stations in Sweden.

30. NÄRKE IN TRADITIONAL COLOURS. Paint and building preservation exhibit. Operated by Övölin paint factory and building preservation.

29. ORNITHOLOGICAL CLUB. Exhibit "Birds on our Doorstep". Operated by the Ornithological Club.

37. THE STÄTARE MUSEUM. A farm labourer home in Karlslund from the 1930's. Operated by Örebro Municipality.

32. THE TECHNICAL MILL. Technical museum filled with technical experiments and a large model railway. Operated by Örebro Municipality.

3. LINÅS BLACKSMITH SHOP AND SKULPTURJÄRNVÄRKET (SCULPTURE IRONWORKS) Art metalworks with an emphasis on commissioned work and site-specific art. Hot-forging classes/corporate events.

31. OVOLIN PAINT FACTORY AND BUILDING PRESERVATION. Building preservation shop with paint, egg tempera manufacturing, building preservation and interior design. Exhibit and sale of ice cream.

34. ROJAN PRODUCTS. Shop with linen designer clothes, leather bags and vests, jewellery and handicrafts made of glass and wood.

3. SJÖSTRAND'S CARPENTRY, BOAT AND CONSTRUCTION. Manufacture of furniture/plant support for the garden. Repairs and making of rowboats.

32. THE TECHNICAL MILL. Technical museum filled with technical experiments and a large model railway. Operated by Örebro Municipality.

🍀 CULTURAL HERITAGE

Welcome to Karlslund

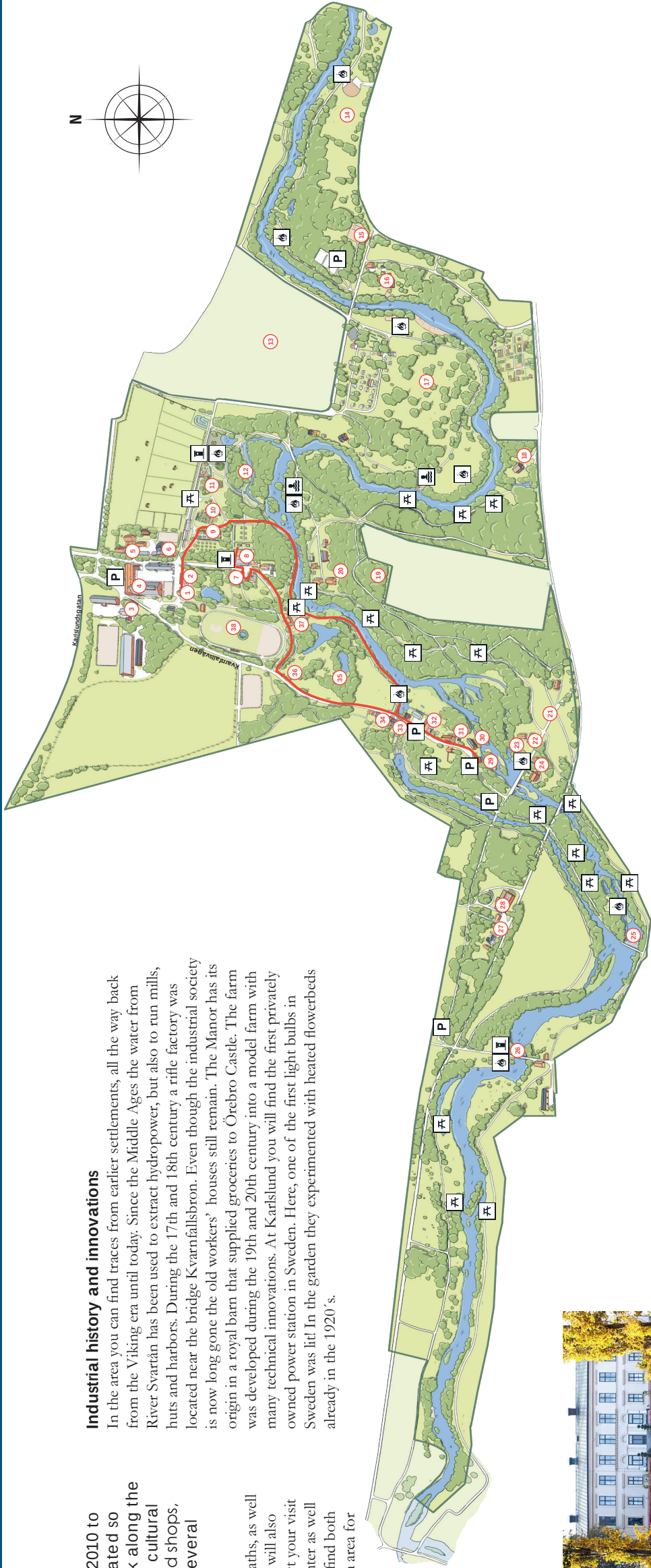
The Cultural Reserve at Karlslund was created in 2010 to preserve and protect this cultural landscape located so close to the city. In Karlslund you can take a walk along the river and experience the manor area with its rich cultural history and diverse nature. In the area you will find shops, craft towns, cafes and exhibits. During the year several public events are also organized in the area.

In the area you will find walkways, bicycle roads and riding paths, as well as places for relaxation and places to have a picnic. Here you will also find studios and club activities as well as riding activities. Start your visit in Ankarsvårds Warehouse where there is an information center as well as an exhibit. In the garden surrounding the Manor you will find both flowerbeds as well as a kitchen garden. There is also a garden area for children to play in.

The Technical Mill with its interactive exhibition and experiments are worth a visit for the entire family. Hästhagen is a place for sport activities and for games such as softball, mini golf, canoe rental and disc golf. There is also a swimming spot here.

Industrial history and innovations

In the area you can find traces from earlier settlements, all the way back from the Viking era until today. Since the Middle Ages the water from River Svartån has been used to extract hydropower, but also to run mills, huts and harbors. During the 17th and 18th century a rifle factory was located near the bridge Kvarnfällsbron. Even though the industrial society is now long gone the old workers' houses still remain. The Manor has its origin in a royal barn that supplied groceries to Örebro Castle. The farm was developed during the 19th and 20th century into a model farm with many technical innovations. At Karlslund you will find the first privately owned power station in Sweden. Here, one of the first light bulbs in Sweden was lit! In the garden they experimented with heated flowerbeds already in the 1920's.

The park promenade is a trail of approximately 2 km with information displays that tell you about the places you are passing.

- Within the reserve it is prohibited to:

1. Destroy or damage any natural or cultural features.

2. Knowingly damage plants or animal life (for example, by digging up plants).

3. Light a fire, except in designated places.

4. Park a caravan without permission from the administrator of the culture reserve.

5. To drive a motor vehicle (with the exception of people with mobility impairments).

6. Park anywhere other than at designated locations.

7. Ride on horseback other than at designated trails/roads/areas.

8. Put up signs or anything similar, other than temporarily.

Exemptions from the reserve regulations:

• Fixed facilities, such as orientation checkpoints or marked trails, may be arranged after consultation with the manager of the Cultural Heritage Reserve.

• For larger events, the manager of the Cultural Heritage Reserve may issue permits for temporary parking and storage.
